SERVICES:

The department deals with all aspects of haematology including the management of lymphoma, leukaemia, myeloma and coagulation disorders (hereditary and acquired, including haemophilia). Haematology Outpatient Clinics are held on Monday and Friday mornings and Wednesday afternoons. There is also a Thrombosis, Haemostasis & Haemophilia Clinic held bimonthly on Tuesday mornings.

GPs are also able to access Pathology services. Full routine and function tests available.
