### Services

As well as the Diagnostic Service offered by the Immunology Department there is also a Clinical Service for the diagnosis and management of disorders of the immune system including immunodeficiencies, autoimmune disease and allergic disorders. This includes inpatient and outpatient services.

Outpatient Clinics include:

- General Immunology and Allergy Clinics
- Anaphylaxis Clinic
- Paediatric Allergy and Immunology Clinic
- Multidisciplinary Vascular Surgery / Immunology Clinic

Patients may be admitted to the Same Day Unit for rush desensitisation to insect venoms, intravenous immunoglobulin, chemotherapy and other procedures.
